Ruki Baillieu is Australia's highest ranked polo professional and among the best in the world. Known for his grit and determination, Ruki is also valued for his consistency on the field. Regarded as one of Australia's most successful polo professionals, as well as being in the world's top 30, he is also one of the highest ranked non-Argentine players on the international circuit and was awarded Most Valuable Visiting player at the 2007 Coronation Cup.

Among his other polo achievements, Ruki has led Australia to victory over England at the 2005 Coronation Cup, has qualified in the Argentine Open in 2007, won the Pacific Coast Open in 2007, and has represented Australia in international Test Matches since 1988. Ruki is also the co-founder of the acclaimed Paspaley Polo in the City series played across the capital cities of Australia.

Traveling the international polo circuit, Ruki spends May to July in the UK, August in Santa Barbara or the Hamptons, September and December in Argentina, and late December to January in Australia. His extensive travels as a professional polo player, together with his confidence, presentation and social skills, allow him to penetrate an exclusive international social set and place him ideally to promote luxury products in a demographic highly valued by premium brands.
